#### **German draft budgetary plan 2019**

Germany's 2019 draft budgetary plan presents the fiscal projections for the budgets of the Federation, Länder, local authorities and social security funds (including their off-budget entities) on the basis of current trends and planning. Sources used as the basis for making these fiscal projections are the draft 2019 federal budget (adopted by the federal government on 6 July 2018) and the financial plan to 2022 (likewise adopted by the federal government on 6 July 2018).



### **German Stability Programme - 2018**

The member states of the European Union submit their medium-term fiscal plans to the European Commission and to the Economic and Financial Affairs Council (ECOFIN) by the end of April each year. To this end, in order to comply with the rules of the Stability and Growth Pact, member states of the euro area submit updated Stability Programmes, while all other EU member states submit updated Convergence Programmes. This update of the German Stability Programme was approved by the federal cabinet on 18. April 2018.


